## Panel 4 / The Role of Women for Peace

### Some key points:

Topic number one was the **Global Petition** "**No Peace without Women**", launched at the Conference by Patricia Elias. For 25 years, UNSCR 1325 has recognized women's equal and meaningful participation as essential to peace and security. GR 40 strengthens this obligation by requiring States to ensure women's full inclusion in all decision-making systems, especially in conflict prevention, resolution, peacebuilding, and recovery. By signing, we call on the UN Secretary General and Deputy Secretary General, World leaders, governments, the United Nations, and regional organizations to take immediate and measurable action to fully implement United Nations Security Council Resolution 1325 on Women, Peace and Security and CEDAW General Recommendation No. 40.
